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1. Setup

Setup for EV Experience takes place on Wednesday 23 and Thursday 24 September according to a phased schedule due to limited space at paddock 1 and the pit lane.

Important setup rules

- Every vehicle must display a loading/unloading pass with contact details. You can find them [here](#)
 - Pit boxes, sky lounges, EV Pavilion, Paddock Club, and paddock areas are no longer accessible to vehicles on Thursday morning.
 - Exhibitors in the EV Pavilion, Paddock Club, and pit boxes must comply with EV Experience stand construction regulations.
 - Vehicle detailers have access until 09:00 on Thursday morning via Paddock 2.
 - Car trailers can be unloaded on Wednesday 23 September at Parking B.
 - Trailers, trucks, and related transport vehicles may be parked at Parking C during the event.
 - During setup and dismantling for the EV Pavilion, unloading at Parking A is preferred.
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2. Dismantling

Dismantling takes place on Saturday 26 September from 17:00 until 23:00.

Important dismantling rules

- Parking C is the only location where cars or materials may remain after dismantling.
 - All other locations must be delivered empty and clean.
 - Cars left at Parking C may be transferred through the EV Experience organization on Monday 28 September.
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3. Stand Construction Regulations

These regulations ensure a safe, tidy, and fair exhibition environment for all exhibitors.

Exhibitors in Pit Boxes

- Build only within the allocated square meters.

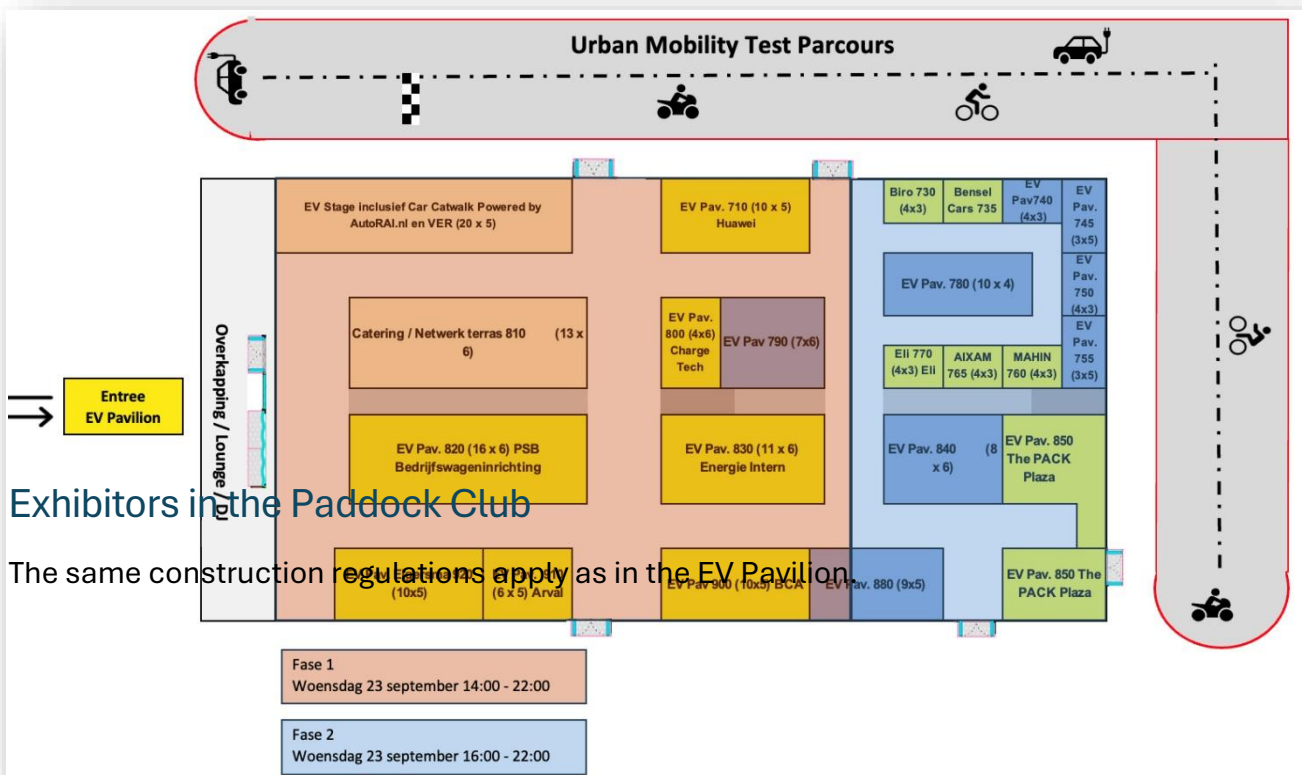
- Decorations outside the pit box are not allowed, except stickers on the pit box edge at the paddock side.
- Any visible back sides of stand walls must be neatly finished.
- No parts may extend beyond stand boundaries.
- A 2-meter open space must remain at the paddock side for visibility and passage.
- One vehicle may be placed outside at a 45-degree angle facing Tarzan Corner.

Exhibitors in Paddock Areas

- Multi-story construction is only permitted after consultation with the organization and circuit.
- Construction must remain within allocated stand space.
- The back side of the stand must be neatly finished.

Exhibitors in the EV Pavilion

- The EV Pavilion is located in an aluminum hall on paddock 2.
- Maximum rear wall height: 2.5 meters.
- Rigging or suspending materials from the roof is not permitted.
- Side and partition walls may only extend to full height over one-third of the stand length.
- Construction must remain within assigned stand boundaries.
- All materials must be fireproof.
- Electrical installations must be safe and professionally installed.
- Noise disturbance toward other exhibitors must be prevented.
- The organization reserves the right to review stand designs in advance.



Exhibitors in the Paddock Club

The same construction regulations apply as in the EV Pavilion.

8. Experience Tickets for Relations

9. Crew Access

Each participant receives complimentary crew tickets. Crew members have access from two hours before opening until two hours after closing.

Allocation

- Pit Box: 20 crew tickets per day
- Paddock Area: 1 ticket per 4 m²
- EV Pavilion / Paddock Club: 6 crew tickets per day

10. Parking

Exhibitor Parking

Participants receive complimentary exit tickets during EV Experience.

Allocation

- Pit Box: 10 exit tickets per day
- Paddock Area: 1 per 16 m²
- EV Pavilion / Paddock Club: 2 exit tickets per day

Parking C is the only area where vehicles or materials may remain after dismantling.

11. Lead Generation

Visitors can scan a QR code to schedule a test drive at a stand or pit box. In exchange for their details, visitors receive a test drive time slot.

Visitor data can also be collected without test drives using the Intercambio Leadsan app.

- Instructors must have valid crew tickets.
 - Insurance for instructors is the exhibitor's responsibility.
 - Vehicle damage and circuit damage are recovered through the driver's liability insurance.
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13. Charging EVs / Charging Plaza

EV Experience 2026 will provide sufficient DC charging stations for test drive vehicles. Further details will follow later.

Please ensure each vehicle key includes a working charging card or charging token.

14. Insurance

Goods and vehicles located on the grounds of Circuit Zandvoort remain entirely at the participant's own risk.

Vehicle insurance for the circuit can be arranged through Allianz.

Coverage includes:

- Third-party liability + comprehensive coverage
 - Premium: €450 per object including insurance tax
 - Deductible: €1,250 per incident
 - Maximum catalog value: €85,000 excluding VAT
 - Coverage only applies on the track and pit lane
 - Tire and rim damage excluded
 - Driving only under guidance of a certified specialist

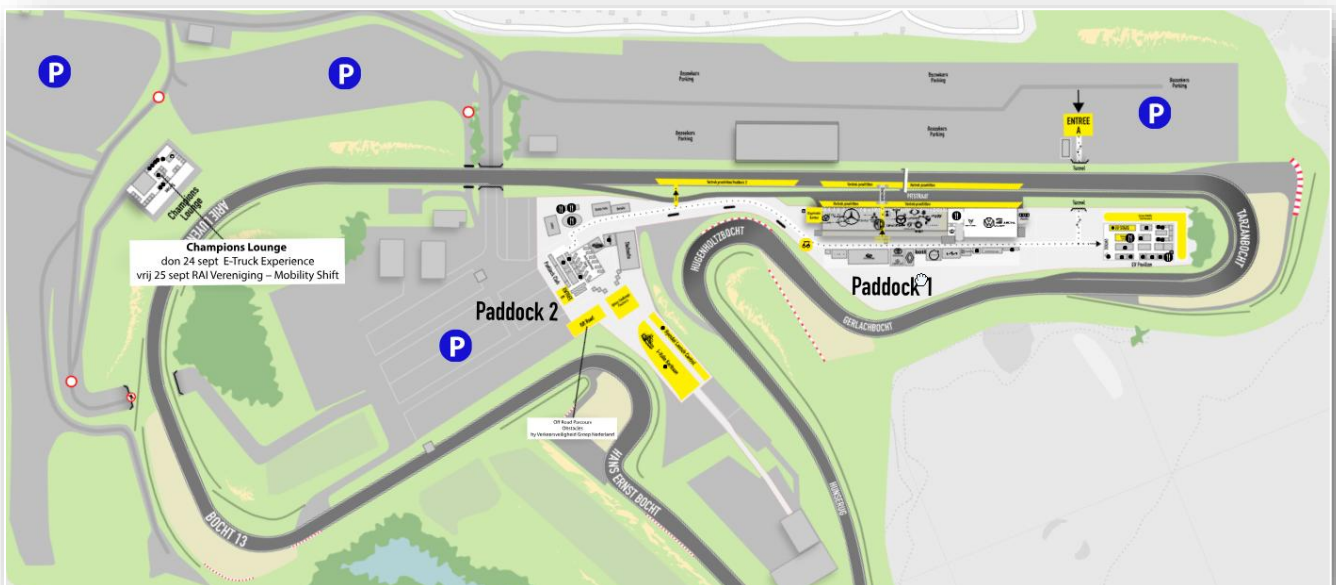

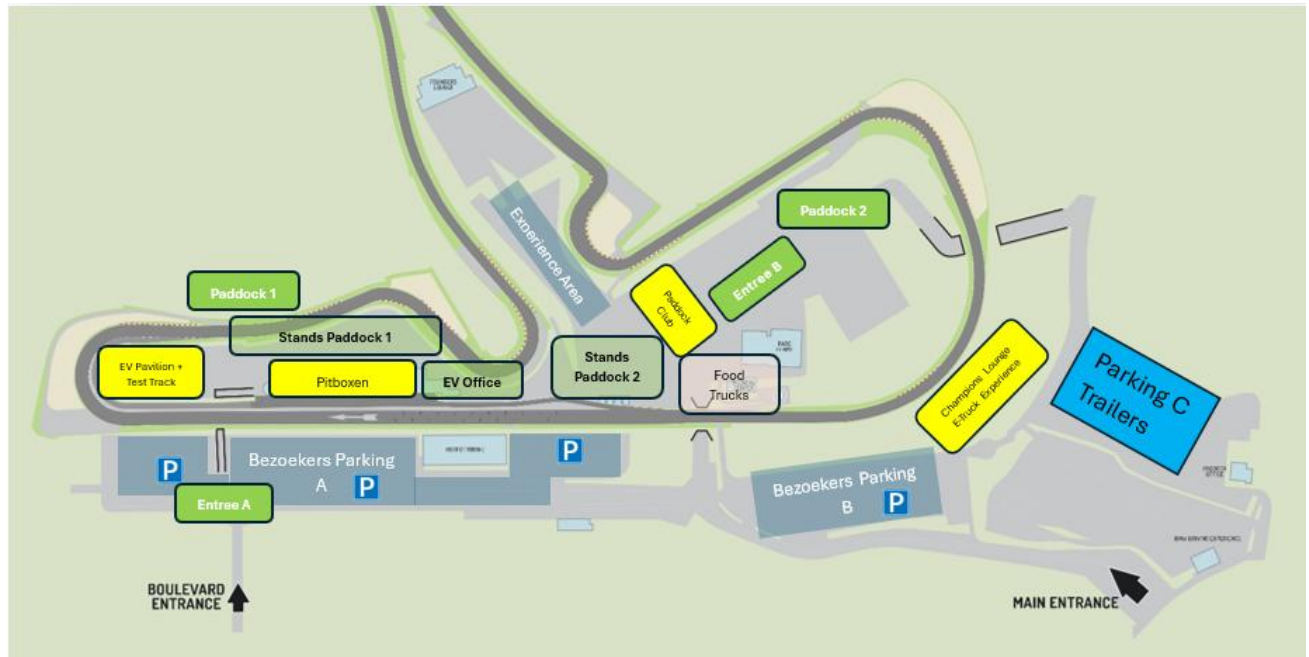
